Testifying is a touchstone of American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS). It simultaneously tells others about our mission and reminds us constantly who we are as a ministry, an organization and interconnected individuals. Importantly, it allows us to weave different voices into one story and makes us better able to discern others' perspectives. We do not testify alone, into emptiness—rather, we do it with and for those around us: God and God's creation.

Hearing the testimony of others is a foundation for relationships that we cultivate with care. In 2022, we took a significant leap forward in reestablishing a sense of community through our flagship national conference, Space for Grace. As one of the first such events to convene in person post-pandemic, this substantial gathering was an occasion to hear—and respond to—stories of faith, hope and resilience that have begun emanating from us as we strive to recover from the traumas of protracted isolation, societal upheaval, disease and death. In words like Paul's, even though we have been afflicted and perplexed, we know we are not crushed or in despair; rather, we are stronger in the knowledge that God's grace is all-encompassing. (*See* 2 Cor. 4:8-9, NRSV)



Another milestone in 2022 was the conclusion of Rebuild, Restore, Renew Puerto Rico, a five-year collaboration that pumped desperately needed resources—both financial and the work of volunteer hands—into an island laid waste by record storms. This effort was led by the testimonies of those affected; they guided ABHMS in determining where the funds, materials and volunteer labor should go.

The call to testify empowers us to bear witness to God's love. As we do so, we look to the master storyteller, teacher and healer, Jesus Christ, who guides his disciples with the power of words, and actions begotten by words, in a world beset by disasters, natural and otherwise, and humankind's own inhumanity. We recognize that words are the foundation for change: Prayer. Teaching through parables. Calls to action.

By taking up these tasks, not least of which is giving testimony, we strive to respond to the challenges of the 21st century in a Christ-like manner, that "the life of Jesus may also be made visible in our bodies." (2 Cor. 4:10, NRSV)

### Leadership Empowerment

#### CCI provides effective springboard for aspiring missional entrepreneurs

A signature program of ABHMS' Leadership Empowerment, the Co-Creators Incubator (CCI) saw the six members of its second cohort, Cycle 2, complete their curriculum in 2022. Like their Cycle 1 predecessors, members of Cycle 2 were buoyed by invaluable resources during the program: continual mentorship, two hands-on summits at ABHMS' Leadership and Mission Building, \$3,000 seed grants and abundant networking opportunities.

Now, several in Cycle 2 are determinedly striving to make their ministry ventures flourish through hard work and additional funding, including Accelerator Grants from ABHMS and Palmer Grants from American Baptist Foundation in collaboration with ABHMS.

Monique Harrington and Jonathan Malone were awarded grants to expand their respective nonprofits,

Way Club and Wilderness Journeys. Way Club, selfdescribed as "a faith-based social club for high school-aged teenagers" in Philadelphia, provides a safe hangout for young people, where they are encouraged to work hard, be their best selves and, most of all, have fun. Malone's Wilderness Journeys, in contrast, extolls the physical and spiritual benefits of communing with nature. It organizes guided hikes in several states across the country

that enable participants to connect with the divine through their outdoor experiences.

"Because of the Accelerator Grant that I received through the Co-Creators Incubator program, I was able to put together a website, which is the central hub of information and sharing about what I am doing," said Malone. With plans underway for at least 15 different trips, he is relishing his call to help youth and adults, both younger and older, to "experience God in wonderful and profound ways in the wilderness."

During the Space for Grace conference in September, three Cycle 2 Co-Creators showcased their work and, in the process, cultivated partnerships and opportunities through ABHMS' expansive networks. Dr. Ruth Alerte Jones described the HEM (Healing. Extension. Maternal.) Network, a faith-based nonprofit she founded to address the spiritual and emotional wellness of women who have lost children in utero. Dria Price presented "Teatime with Dria," a chronicle of her co-founding of Justevia, an eco-friendly producer of tea blends that are healthy, refreshing alternatives to sugar-laden drinks. And musician and educator Alex Zarecki performed his own compositions, the writing of which he attributed to new-found creative freedom made possible through participation in the CCI.

### Supporting filmmakers' mission to chart new course for Christians

Leadership Empowerment liaised on a \$10,000 ABHMS grant in 2022 that helped Marisa Prince and because of an "appetite for ... content that grapples Calvin Lee, entrepreneurs and founders of faith-based media nonprofit Standing in the Gap, realize their vision of producing "Are We There YET." This short film depicts the cross-country journey of a group of evangelical outsiders seeking to better understand the Doctrine of Discovery. The doctrine—a principle under which nations that "discover" land acquire rights to it—provided the spiritual, political and legal justification for the colonization and seizure of land inhabited by Native Americans.

Through their storytelling, the filmmakers reveal a nexus between the doctrine and Christian nationalism and explore the possibility of charting a new course for Christians in the United States that leads to eradicating inequity and modeling the unity of God.

Prince believes the film will resonate widely with how our faith can engage the world. There's a hunger for honesty, equity, freedom and justice in our faith communities ... in the media we consume."



### New online course encourages innovation in faith practices

Leadership Empowerment collaborated with the ABHMS Center for Continuous Learning to offer Ministry Entrepreneurship, a new four-week virtual course on developing innovative ideas for community-focused faith practices. The inaugural cohort, which included pastors and other Christian leaders, volunteers and Jesus-minded entrepreneurs craving innovation, convened in October under the guidance of Tony Gapastione, a CCI mentor and alumnus.

### Rebuild, Restore, Renew Puerto Rico engenders indelible legacy of hope

Despite Jesus' clear rebuttal of the notion that natural disasters are divine punishment, some people still choose to interpret them as God's wrath visited on the sinful or unworthy. Regrettably, such beliefs ignore the truth of modern realities—human excess drives the global warming that is spawning ever more destructive and deadly weather events, while societal inequities ensure that those who are improverished, disabled or otherwise marginalized disproportionately bear the hardships caused by catastrophies such as Hurricane Maria, which ravaged Puerto Rico in 2017.

Action on a global scale to remediate humanity's contributions to climate change is a moral imperative; however, it is our rapid response to the devastation caused by cataclysmic winds and torrential rain that manifests our greatest immediate potential to be Christ-like.

Rebuild, Restore, Renew Puerto Rico (RRR PR) was a five-year, large-scale humanitarian mission spearheaded by ABHMS in response to the devastation and traumas originally inflicted on the island and its inhabitants in 2017 and prolonged by subsequent forces of nature. As important, RRR PR

brought together organizations—ABHMS, Iglesias Bautistas de Puerto Rico (IBPR), eight missions, eight Baptist schools and academies, Corporación Milagros de Amor and Seminario Evangélico de Puerto Rico—that coalesced into a highly effective alliance capable of overcoming daunting obstacles to achieve transformational outcomes.

2022 saw the culmination of RRR PR, and we now rejoice in its success, visible in repaired and rebuilt buildings, restored lives and renewed communities.

## Select RRR PR highlights



- Partnerships formed under RRR PR facilitated the rebuilding or restoration of 35 churches, 11 organizations or retreat centers and 118 homes across the island between 2017 and 2022.
- The initiative strategically channeled \$536,474.69 to Puerto Rico to finance reconstruction, provide direct financial support and fund scholarships, among other things.
- Eleven Disaster Response Centers, created after Maria for the collection and distribution of emergency supplies, remain in the service of IBPR, with continuing strategic and logistical support from ABHMS. These centers were activated following a 2020 earthquake, Tropical Storm Isaías that same year and Hurricane Fiona in 2022.
- ABHMS helped to establish a community garden to promote greater self-reliance and supplement food sources.
- Judson Press, an ABHMS publication ministry, helped to raise funds for the Juan de Valdés library of Seminario Evangélico de Puerto Rico to replace destroyed books.
- ABHMS contributed more than 1,200 solar- and battery-powered lamps and 500 water purifiers following Hurricane Fiona, which caused record flooding and mudslides that resulted in an island-wide blackout and a severe shortage of potable water.

- Between 2017 and 2022 under RRR PR, the island received 104 groups of volunteers, with a total of 1,391 individuals contributing 41,868 workhours.
- Spiritual and emotional support was provided for ministry professionals and pastoral families. Between 2018 and 2021, nearly 200 clergy and other ministry professionals participated in one or more of four retreats, and scholarships were made available to pastoral families for counseling therapy.
- Groundwork was laid for a broader, long-term strategy to address Puerto Rico's future needs and provide vital advocacy on a national level. This has included establishing relationships with faith and humanitarian organizations both in Puerto Rico and the United States, among them Baptists on Mission, Servicios Sociales Luteranos, FEMA, the American Red Cross, American Baptist Churches USA and the National Baptist Convention of America.

### Continuing to set the table for compelling conversations

Responsible stewardship of creative endeavors; mental health within homes, congregations and communities; pathways to immigration reform; and advocacy for persons with disability in the workplace were among the subjects of the Justice Dialogues ABHMS hosted in 2022, the third year of the program.

ABHMS continues to convene these sessions to address the concerns and curiosities of many American Baptists about circumstances in our world that directly impact us as individuals or otherwise

embroil us because of their effect on those we love. The dialogues create an opportunity for participants to become more informed, suggest solutions and ask questions among colleagues who share similar concerns or interests.

### Intercultural Ministries

#### Nurturing the cultural proficiency of American Baptist leaders

In November, Intercultural Ministries successfully concluded its second Intercultural Leadership Institute (ILI), a yearlong program fashioned around the goal of building a network of culturally competent leaders across the United States and Puerto Rico on a robust biblical and theological foundation. The inaugural ILI was held from 2019 through 2020.

The Rev. Alicia Dixon-Garrard, lead pastor and planter of the Community of Grace of the Southern Tier in New York and one of more than 50 learners from 18 states and Puerto Rico, valued her experience. "I enjoyed the deep sense of community

and solidarity formed in this cohort," she said. "The safe space to grow in self-awareness and gain tools to do this intercultural work was a gift that isn't easily found elsewhere for clergy."

The latest ILI, a combination of in-person and online gatherings, kicked off in November 2021 with a multi-day residency at ABHMS' Leadership and Mission Building (LAMB) in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, where the Rev.

Dr. Miguel De La Torre, professor of Social Ethics and Latinx Studies at the Iliff School of Theology in Denver, delivered his keynote, "Rejecting Eurocentric Christianity," to a rapt audience.

The cohort then reconvened three times in 2022. February and June were virtual sessions, with the latter a storytelling workshop facilitated by movie producer Avril Z. Speaks. In November, the ILI concluded in a multi-day residency in the LAMB, where the Rev. Kathryn ("Katie") Choy-Wong took center stage. The coauthor of "Building Lasting



Bridges: An Updated Handbook for Intercultural Ministries" conducted a skill-building workshop on cultural identity, cultural reinforcement and cross-cultural interactions. This was reinforced by facilitated discussions and periods of reflection, which rounded out the schedule.

Lessons learned and knowledge gained from the past two ILIs will help to illuminate a strategic path to achieving greater intercultural competency, according to the Rev. Dr. Marie Onwubuariri, Intercultural Ministries director. "The coming year will be an opportune time to reconnect with the participants of our two cohorts to discuss the next level of training needed for their ongoing leadership journey," she said, adding, "Cultivating intercultural leaders who are self-aware, competent and transformational is a long and complex process, and the needs are as diverse as God's people."

### **ABHMS supports burgeoning Latino Christian National Network**

Approximately 20 years ago, Latino leaders from Protestant churches started a movement which expanded in 2013 to include Pentecostal, evangelical and Catholic churches, as well as other Christian denominations and organizations. The result was a unique space for the Latino Christian family. In September, what started as a movement reached a critical milestone—the official launch of the Latino Christian National Network (LCNN) and its first formal gathering in Washington, D.C.

ABHMS, one of more than 30 organizations at this historic assemblage, was duly represented by the Rev. Dr. Marie Onwubuariri, director of Intercultural Ministries; the Rev. Lisa Harris Lee,

director of Healing & Transforming Communities; and the Rev. Abigaíl Medina Betancourt, national coordinator for Intercultural Engagement. Leading up to the event, Medina Betancourt had worked on the planning committee. She also presented during the gathering on the prophetic role of the church during a session titled "The Church God Needs Today."

Further ABHMS involvement included awarding grants totaling \$5,000 to enable the participation of young American Baptist youth leaders, some of whom appeared as panelists for a session titled "Younger Leaders Reflect on the Present and Future of the Church."

### Native American Baptist leaders receive much-valued training

Native American Ministries (NAM) successfully delivered three online workshops, part of its Native American Leadership Training Series, to 65 mostly Native American leaders in 2022. Founded and developed to provide instruction and resources to pastors and other ministry leaders of Native American nations, the series is intended to enhance their ability to address the plethora of challenges, both cultural and geographic, they confront daily.

The workshops covered three key subjects based on expressed need. The first focused on higher level strategic planning, while the second delved into leveraging modern technologies and social media communications. The final workshop addressed challenges associated with developing a successful youth ministry.

"We are just beginning to discern the impact of the training," said the Rev. Ben Sullivan, national coordinator for NAM. "We have had positive feedback from the Native [American] leaders who attended the sessions and look forward to hearing more about how they are applying what they learned to build more impactful ministries."


### Converge at Space for Grace

ABHMS premiered its Spiritual Caregivers Conference during the week of Space for Grace as a groundbreaking experience created specifically for chaplains, pastoral counselors, spiritual directors and all who discern a call to these ministries. The inaugural event featured two days of learning experiences, resource sharing and networking.

Conference attendees also celebrated the official launch of the American Baptist National Network of Chaplains, Pastoral Counselors & Specialized Ministers with much excitement and fanfare. This network is facilitated by liaisons located throughout the United States and Puerto Rico.

During a post-event debrief, the conference planning team, uniformly delighted by the overwhelmingly positive feedback from guests, characterized the first Spiritual Caregivers Conference as a "near-epic" success.

### Center for Continuous Learning

### Offering valuable resources to increase resiliency post-pandemic

The COVID-19 pandemic left many of the faithful traumatized and pastoral leaders ill-prepared to render needed assistance. The ABHMS Center for Continuous Learning (CCL) responded by teaming up with the Philadelphia Baptist Association to provide ministry professionals with effective, trauma-informed resources via a May workshop titled "A Future with Hope: Resilient Responses in COVID-Era Ministry."

The daylong event, held in person at ABHMS' Leadership and Mission Building and streamed live, tackled numerous topics, including issues that surround creating healing communities within congregations, the church's role in providing practical assistance to others and ways to adjust to permanent pandemic-induced changes.

A packed agenda featured professor, clinical psychologist and Judson Press author Jessica Young Brown, Ph.D., who stressed in her keynote that the COVID era demands ministries to be flexible, strong and, importantly, trauma informed. This address

was followed by breakout sessions on fostering hope within congregations and nurturing resilience in children and youth, with each session offering numerous opportunities for Q&A.

Said the Rev. Dr. Rebecca Irwin-Diehl, director of the CCL, about the day, "Attendees departed with a renewed sense of hope and an abundant toolkit."

### Select courses in the CCL's 2022 program portfolio

- Chaplaincy Skills for Community Ministry, a popular six-week, cohort-based course facilitated by the Rev. Dr. Patricia Murphy, ABHMS/ ABCUSA ecclesiastical endorser.
- Ministry Entrepreneurship, an intensive online course facilitated over four sessions by Co-Creator and CCI mentor Tony Gapastione.
- Foundations of Faithful Finance, a six-week, cohort-based course designed to increase the financial literacy of ministry leaders.
- How to Be a Hybrid Church, a rigorous cohortbased course for congregations and their leadership teams facilitated by Christen Kinard, co-founder of Digital Congregations.
- Native American Leadership Training, a three-part webinar series.
- Asian American and Burma Diaspora Leader Training, a four-part webinar series.
- CeCaLi XXII, a four-part Spanish language leadership training series launched in 2009 for those in pastoral ministry.

## ABHMS prioritizes financial literacy education for clergy

Responding to an ABHMS missional imperative of encouraging pastors to elevate their financial acumen, the CCL enrolled spring and fall cohorts in Foundations of Faithful Finance in 2022. The six-week online course, part of an inclusive finance curriculum, was designed specifically to help learners develop a fundamental understanding and vocabulary about financial systems and practices, as well as establish their own underlying money values. Each cohort was composed of ministers drawn from populations the CCL had identified as underserved with relevant financial education.

Foundations of Faithful Finance was built and delivered by Shayna Harvey, a certified financial advisor and author whose Judson Press title, "Money on Purpose: Finding a Faith-Filled Balance," provided the underlying framework of the course based on practical strategies for financial management within a broader faith perspective.

"I learned so much," said a member of the spring cohort about her experience in the multifaceted course. "[My husband, also a pastor, and I] are implementing what we are learning and making the necessary changes to live a life of generosity and financial health. Please know that your work is impacting people and words cannot express my gratitude."

Since 2016, ABHMS has been helping pastors and congregations to strengthen their financial literacy through the generosity of the Lilly Foundation Inc.

### ministrElife

### Technology and online resources help ministry professionals excel

ABHMS long envisioned a secure network of digitally interconnected ministry professionals. Members of this online community would benefit throughout their careers from innovative communication tools and a spectrum of resources targeting vocation-specific needs. MinistrElife, the first iteration of this network, was built by outside talents from an ABHMS blueprint and launched in 2019 to much fanfare. In 2022, ABHMS took another sizable step, embarking on a mission to create the next generation of the platform for its community of users. remotely make all the difference. I really felt collegial

From the beginning, ministrElife was closely monitored. And this ongoing performance analysis, coupled with a comprehensive audit and invaluable feedback from current clients, yielded key findings that recently informed a critical decision: bring the platform entirely in-house and produce a more robust application that delivers greater value. ABHMS would completely entrust ministrElife and its ongoing development to a fully internal, crossdisciplinary team.

Over several months, a transfer of infrastructure and application development efforts occurred, and the ministrElife team, in collaboration with ABHMS' information technology unit, effected platform updates. Of greater significance, planning began in earnest for a major, data-informed upgrade that would expand the current capabilities and offerings of ministrElife and significantly enhance the user experience. ABHMS anticipates a limited beta release of ministrElife Version 2 in the latter part of 2023.

While work was advancing on the platform, the ministrElife core team of the Rev. Erica Van Brakle, director, and the Rev. Megan Biddle, assistant

director, took to the road. They visited 14 American Baptist regions to conduct trainings intended to reinvigorate interest among registered ministrElife users, encourage them to complete their professional profiles and swell the number of new registrations.

Commenting on the high-touch approach of the core team, the Rev. Jacki Belile from ABC Metro Chicago said this about her ministrElife training: "Erica's global detailed understanding of the platform and radical availability to support in person and advocacy at its best and am so relieved my profile has been updated and ready for God's next thing!"

### Unique online show about ministry reaches growing audience

The streaming show quickly found a small audience that has been growing steadily.

Dahlberg Peace and Justice Award recipient and a retired executive director of American Baptist International Ministries.




Judson Press continued its sponsorship of ABC Reads, a longstanding program that was developed to bring American Baptists together through the power of reading. The 2022 selection was professor and pastor Jennifer Davidson's "River of Life, Feast of Grace: Baptism, Communion, and Discipleship." In it, the author considers the historical theology of the Christian rites of baptism and communion from a Baptist perspective and follows with an exploration of the practical implications of these rituals for a life of radical discipleship.

### Judson Press casts its gaze forward

In 2022, just two years shy of the 200th anniversary of the founding of its antecedent, the Baptist General Tract Society, Judson Press began preparations for its next century as a creator and purveyor of Christian literature and other resources for the faithful. Over the year, the Rev. Dr. Cheryl Price, publisher, reflected on the past, present and future of ABHMS' publishing ministry. Importantly, she and her team reimagined opportunities for authors from Baptist and other denominations to write challenging, transformational work for an evolving faith audience.

"We are laying the groundwork for a revitalized Judson Press that could include alternative publishing models for the original imprint," said Price. "We are also exploring the viability of a new, distinct imprint built around a model that favors greater author investment in the publishing process." She added that the new imprint would further distinguish itself by entertaining book ideas on a wider array of topics than those currently associated with Judson Press.

### Resources for Good

#### ABHMS grant inspires cross-cultural engagement

A worship space in Lincoln, Nebraska, home to the First Baptist Church there, became a locus of multiculturalism with the launch of the outreach ministry K Street Lunch in 2022. Brainchild of the Rev. Joy Martinez-Marshall, the church's pastor, and made possible through a \$5,000 ABHMS grant, the free meal program was intended to offer sustenance to those in need. It accomplished much more.

Though Martinez-Marshall spearheaded the initiative, K Street Lunch evolved into a collaboration of three distinct congregations sharing the same building. First Baptist Church, composed mostly of older white Midwesterners, banded together with Lincoln Karen Baptist Church, a ministry of Karen immigrants from Burma, and Livingston Christian Church, consisting mainly of South Sudanese, to host the weekly lunches.

First Baptist Church had been insular prior to the lunch project, according to Martinez-Marshall. The congregation did not involve itself with others, even Christians under the same roof. But something sparked, and "we were finally doing ministry together despite having shared space for so many years," she said.

K Street Lunch concluded at year's end after having served hundreds of meals. Yet for First Baptist Church, the positive effects of the program have endured and manifested in unexpected ways. These include new relationships with other American Baptist churches in Lincoln, the Women's Ministry of Nebraska and the nearby Savannah Pines Retirement Community. "From my perspective as the pastor," said Martinez-Marshall, "the funding has given the church new life."

### Conexión's 'Inmersión' engages youth, pastors, churches with ABHMS support

ABHMS collaborated with the National Hispanic Caucus in 2022 on Conexión Nacional Juvenil Latina (Conexión), which connects Hispanic Baptist youth belonging to American Baptist churches in the United States and Puerto Rico. Conexión focuses on elevating the next generation of youth leadership, establishing communications among regional youth ministries and providing youth training workshops on a national level.

Conexión had received a total of \$5,000 in ABHMS grants for its "Inmersión" projects, which engaged churches, pastors and youth in specific locales over several days. During April's "Inmersión San Francisco," Conexión worked with 10 churches, 12 pastors and 130 youth through intergenerational

workshops and other activities. Similarly, "Inmersión Chicago" in September impacted 18 churches, 14 pastors and more than 200 youth across Chicagoland and Southeast Wisconsin.






### 2022 contributions sources

### Common Investment Fund

Socially responsible investing (SRI) is a hallmark of ABHMS' Common Investment Fund (CIF). Through SRI, the CIF seeks not only to maximize financial returns, but also to use shareholder power to hold corporations in which ABHMS is invested accountable to just and equitable business practices related to social and environmental issues. The pandemic's impact on health and worker human rights continued to reemphasize the importance of ABHMS' SRI advocacy.

ABHMS' priority SRI issues include affordable drug pricing, human rights, racial justice, climate

change, environmental justice and responsible financial practices. Corporate engagement around these issues is planned annually in collaboration with ABHMS' Socially Responsible Investment Advisory Council (SRIAC) and our SRI consultant, Investor Advocates for Social Justice.

In 2022—in partnership with members of the Interfaith Center for Corporate Responsibility (ICCR)—ABHMS pressed companies, such as Amazon, Chevron, Hershey and Tyson Foods, to improve management of environmental, social and governance risks.

### Highlights of 2022 shareholder engagements

- Amazon: Building on the 48.8% vote of the 2022 proposal related to customer due diligence of Amazon's surveillance products, ABHMS filed a shareholder proposal requesting a report on customer due diligence on issues related to surveillance, privacy and racial justice associated with facial recognition and surveillance technologies and government relationships.
- In 2022, ABHMS co-filed a shareholder proposal with Chevron requesting a Racial Equity Audit (REA), which received 48% support. ABHMS plans to re-file the REA proposal for 2023.
- Regarding Hershey, ABHMS continues to lead dialogues on human rights and sustainable agriculture, with a core focus on child labor in the cocoa supply chain. ABHMS urges the company to implement the Human Rights Policy adopted in 2020 and to consider a living wage for its cocoa workers.
- ABHMS continues to engage with Tyson Foods, and now prioritizes issues around human rights. Ongoing shareholder pressure, including a 2022 shareholder proposal with Tyson Foods led by ABHMS, has won unprecedented support for reforms of the company's human rights practices. This engagement called attention to dangerous worker health and safety conditions in Tyson facilities during COVID-19, and the shareholder proposal filed by ABHMS received an unprecedented 78.7% of independent shareholder support. A racial equity audit is in process.
- In 2022, ABHMS continued the strategy for SRI impact priorities for the related \$2 million Socially Responsible Mission Directed Fund. The priorities are regional focus areas (Puerto Rico and the Southeast United States), support for racial justice, access to capital for under-served groups, and environmental justice or climate change mitigation. Investment was made in the Raven Capital II Fund focusing on Indigenous people's business development in Canada and the U.S.




