

Judson Press celebrates 200 years!






We welcomed 18 new authors to the publication, nine of them women. Of the total number of articles published, 57 (or 35%) were by women writers.

Leadership Empowerment



ABHMS delegation visits American Baptist ministries in Alaska

In early June, Dr. Jeffrey Haggray, director of the Leadership and Empowerment team, led a delegation of ABHMS staff, including Michael Birdsell, the Rev. Dr. Rebecca Irwin-Diehl, the Rev. Dr. Marie Onwubuariri, the Rev. Saeed Richardson, and Alexandria Sanchez, to American Baptist ministries in Alaska.

Their itinerary included the Kodiak Baptist Mission (KBM), founded in 1893 by the Woman's American Baptist Home Mission Society; Camp Woody on Woody Island; First American Baptist Church in Anchorage, pastored by the Rev. Dr. Patricia A. Wilson-Cone; and the 2024 ABC of Alaska Baptist Churches State Convention at the Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church in Anchorage. They were also blessed to spend time with Dr. Alonzo Patterson, ABHMS' national coordinator of Alaska Ministries.

Kodiak Baptist Mission is a unique Christian mission that specializes in children's and family ministries. They offer a wide variety of outdoor and indoor camps, programs, and events, most of them designed for children ages 8-14, and year-round, they run their heritage farm and ranch with the only Grade A-certified goat dairy in Alaska that offers a specialized internship program for the youth. Outdoor activities for children and youth at KBM

include horseback riding, kayaking, and archery. Indoor activities include cooking, painting, quilting, felting, and crocheting.

In Anchorage, the delegation visited several churches and other sites. Before the beginning of the convention, they also enjoyed fellowship with the pastoral staff of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church and Patterson. Haggray opened the convention with a sermon; on Friday, Onwubuariri preached.

These in-person visits are essential for ABHMS staff. "They enable us to pursue our mission, always keeping collaboration and contextual relevance in consideration," said Onwubuariri. "Takeaways for me were forming new relationships with ministry colleagues and learning more of the intercultural possibilities of the region."

Chaplaincy event: “Spiritual Care: Chaplains Beyond Religious Roles”

On October 19, the American Baptist Network of Chaplains, Pastoral Counselors & Specialized Ministers, and the Chaplains & Pastoral Counselors Chapter of the American Baptist Ministers Council gathered approximately 70 ministry professionals in person and online for an annual training session. Titled “Spiritual Care: Chaplains Beyond Religious Roles,” this event marked the first time in the history of both groups that they convened jointly for such training, setting the stage for enriched fellowship, networking, and professional development.

Speakers included Rick Barnes, president of the Chaplains & Pastoral Counselors Chapter; the Rev. Sarah Fogg; the Rev. Dr. Patricia Murphy, BCC, ABHMS/ABCUSA ecclesiastical endorser; the Rev. Dr. Anne Dondapati Allen; and the Rev. Dr. Petra van de Water-van Driel. Participants in the training departed with a sense of empowerment and practical tools for addressing their roles’ ethical and emotional challenges. Through their collaborative efforts, the

Chaplaincy Network and Ministers Council demonstrated a shared commitment to supporting the well-being of chaplains and spiritual caregivers, equipping them to face the ethical and emotional demands of their work with resilience and compassion while fostering a supportive community dedicated to holistic care.

Meet Saisih Nawnkahr, 2024 recipient of the Daniel E. Weiss Scholarship

American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS) named Saisih Nawnkahr as the 2024 recipient of the Daniel E. Weiss Scholarship, a distinguished merit-based award that supports theological education and ministry leadership. Nawnkahr will use her award to offset tuition expenses as she pursues a Master of Divinity (M.Div.) at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary in Evanston, Illinois. The scholarship is renewable for a maximum of three years.

Born and raised in Myanmar, Nawnkahr grew up in the Baptist church there, which shaped her faith and sense of purpose. “I’ve always been inclined to learn about the Bible—its history and theology,” she reflected, admitting that “going to seminary was not one of my dreams.”

Nawnkahr describes receiving the Weiss Scholarship as a blessed and humbling experience that “not only enables me to go to seminary but, more importantly, affirms my calling.” To serve in ministry focused on teaching and counseling, she will apply the scholarship funds to her graduate program “and some courses on pastoral care and counseling.”

Healing & Transforming Communities

Disaster response

Throughout 2024, a particularly devastating year in terms of the number and severity of natural disasters, ABHMS diligently worked to support spiritually and financially communities across the United States and Puerto Rico affected by natural disasters.

In April, tornadoes, flash floods, and severe winds resulted in lives lost, devastated property, and widespread power outages across the Central United States, from Texas to Wisconsin. In July, Hurricane Beryl wreaked havoc with devastating winds, rain, and resultant flooding that claimed ten lives across Texas and Louisiana. Also, in July, hot temperatures, low precipitation, and gusty wind made the land especially vulnerable to rapidly spreading conflagrations. Wildfires ravaged California, Oregon, Nevada, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico, Arizona, Colorado, South Dakota and Nebraska locations.

August brought life-threatening hurricanes to Puerto Rico and the Southeast United States. After making landfall on Florida's Gulf Coast on August 5 as a Category 1 hurricane, Debby unleashed tornadoes and torrential rains that caused at least seven fatalities in the United States and widespread flooding along its nearly week-long trek up the East Coast toward Canada. A week later, Tropical Storm Ernesto formed in the mid-Atlantic, rapidly intensifying to Hurricane Ernesto. Two days later, it struck a glancing blow to Puerto Rico, resulting in a loss of electricity across half of the island.

The 2024 Atlantic hurricane season, which reached its zenith with back-to-back Hurricanes Helene and Milton, marked one of the deadliest in United States history. Across the Gulf Coast and deep into Appalachia, more than 300 lives were lost amid unfathomable destruction.

Through One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS), donations were directed to the designated disaster areas in the United States and Puerto Rico within weeks of an event to address immediate needs. "Our generosity is the answer to someone's prayers," said the Rev. Lisa Harris Lee, director of Healing & Transforming Communities, coordinating disaster response at ABHMS. "We work to disburse resources and volunteers months and years after natural disasters because the needs for recovery and rebuilding often remain long after the initial impact. We are still supporting rebuilding efforts in western and eastern Kentucky since the 2021 tornado and 2022 floods."

A much-valued partnership that benefits all generations in Billings, Montana

ABHMS celebrated a 15-year partnership with Friendship House of Christian Service (Friendship House) in Billings, Montana. Over this period, ABHMS has awarded grants to Friendship House to assist children and teens in several ways, emphasizing providing food, scholarships, and learning resources. In 2021 and 2022, the two latest grants helped the nonprofit purchase fitness equipment and fresh foodstuffs, respectively.

Today, Friendship House is supported by more than 40 local churches, 25 community partners, and 15 service clubs. Over the years, it has done many things: “Everything from a food bank to a

clothing pantry to a thrift store,” said its executive director, the Rev. Matt Lundgren.

The ministry offers five programs created in response to a community survey that identified the needs of South Side residents: a preschool, an after-school program, a teen program, adult education, and mental health counseling. “We’re trying to serve the whole family from birth all the way. Our oldest participant is 103,” added Lundgren with pride.

Summer Passionary Institute welcomed a second cohort of participants

The Summer Passionary Institute (SPI), a unique initiative of ABHMS, launched its second cohort on May 16. Seven SPI interns and three SPI ambassadors convened with ABHMS staff in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, for an intensive three-day orientation in preparation for the immersive experience the “passionaries” began on June 2.

ABHMS launched the SPI in 2023 specifically to nurture passionaries, which are described as individuals who engage in the extraordinary work of healing and transforming communities through the embodiment of Christ’s love and the power of the Holy Spirit.

In 2024, the original SPI program evolved into the SPI + Emerging Leaders Cohort (SPI + ELC), combining the summer internship with year-round skills development. The SPI + ELC aimed for the passionaries to achieve three key outcomes: Engage

deeply with peers through meaningful interactions while exploring formative questions; achieve greater vocational alignment through exposure to experiences that resonate with their evolving life callings; and develop empathy by connecting deeply with those facing challenging circumstances.

Oklahoma Native American churches receive technology support, training

When Dr. Jeffrey Haggray, ABHMS' executive director, visited Native American churches in Oklahoma in 2022, his team assessed the need for improving their technology and internet access for Native American churches. With funding from Native American Ministries, they received the equipment in February 2024. They were visited in September by Rev. Ben Sullivan, national coordinator for Native American Ministries, and the Rev. Saeed Richardson, chief technology & information security officer, and Mary-Anne Walker, IT support services associate.

The new technology included monitors, laptops, PA systems, Zoom accounts, and cameras. The project is progressing into 2025 and beyond; the goal is to enhance community access to technology and resources, bridging the gap between urban and rural communities and improving Native American participation in church activities and online events. The initiative also includes ongoing training and support, with quarterly check-ins to ensure the technology is effectively utilized.

"This equipment will help churches conduct meetings, provide community access to the internet, and host training sessions," said Sullivan. "The goal is to support all 24 churches in the region eventually."

Partnering with MBMM to help diverse American Baptist leaders build bridges across cultural differences

In late September, several ABHMS staff traveled to Framingham, Massachusetts, to participate in the “Allelon” (Greek for “one another”) gathering of the Massachusetts Baptist Multicultural Ministries (MBMM). Themed “Building Bridges with One Another” and connected to MBMM’s Thriving Pastoral Ministry Program (TPMP), the gathering focused on clergy of different ethnic and racial backgrounds having bold and honest conversations about ways to connect and dismantle barriers that prevent meaningful engagement.

“We hope that the Allelon gathering will improve race/theological/cultural/ethnic relations in our community/church and just being there in the conference

will have been an important step,” said the Rev. Dr. Mar Imsong, MBMM’s executive director. “Now it is our task to build a collective vision.”

The event promises to have lasting benefits for attendees. According to the Rev. Jim Leavitt, director of TPMP, “around 60% of those who provided evaluations indicated a willingness to meet with other ethnic clergy groups multiple times throughout the year.”

ABHMS organizes a webinar in Creole on immigrant rights

In December 2024, anticipating the incoming administration’s changes to immigration law, the Rev. Abigail Medina Betancourt, national coordinator for Intercultural and Haitian ministries, helped organize a webinar on legal issues for Haitian immigrants. Delivered by Emmanuel Coffy, Esq., the presentation covered numerous topics, including communication strategies to be employed with ICE officers, the requirement of a judge’s signature for a search warrant to be valid, and the need to limit interactions with the police, especially those with the potential to escalate, such as traffic stops.

The webinar proved useful, as on January 20, 2025, President Trump ended the humanitarian parole program called CHNV (Cuba, Haiti, Nicaragua, Venezuela), leaving some Haitians anxious about their future in the United States. “Some people’s fate is uncertain now... They are

concerned,” said the Rev. Dr. Older Azard, senior minister at Bethel Haitian Baptist Church in New Jersey, who facilitated the webinar. “I wanted the lawyer to come to clarify some of the questions they may have had. And, of course, they did have questions.”

Significant grants strengthen ABHMS mission

Nurturing Children Initiative underwritten by \$1.25 million grant from Lilly Endowment

Faith communities have sought meaningful ways to engage children in worship for generations, nurturing their spiritual development from an early age. Thanks to a \$1.25 million grant from Lilly Endowment Inc. awarded in November 2024, ABHMS is poised to help congregations embrace innovative, inclusive approaches to children's faith formation.

Awarded through the Endowment's "Nurturing Children Through Worship and Prayer Initiative," the grant will fund ABHMS' "Nurturing Children Initiative," a five-year program designed to equip churches with research-based methods for engaging children—from newborns to age 12—in intergenerational worship.

The Nurturing Children Initiative is intended to stimulate innovation. The Rev. Daryn Bunce Stylianopoulos, program director, Nurturing Children Initiative, acknowledges that historic practices—children's sermons, Sunday school, and age-specific ministries—continue to have value. "This isn't about erasing those spaces," she explained. "It's about discerning how to balance them with new shared worship opportunities and find the most life-

giving way for each congregation to fully honor the spiritual lives of children."

Through cohort-based communities of practice, ABHMS will bring together congregations, child development experts, and faith leaders to develop worship and prayer experiences that align with children's developmental stages. A special focus will be placed on ensuring inclusive practices for children with disabilities.

The initiative is part of ABHMS' ongoing mission to strengthen the future of faith communities by engaging all generations in meaningful worship. As congregations reimagine their approach to worship, this initiative will empower children to know God, share God's love, and grow in faith.



New program to empower Latino leadership supported by \$1.5 million grant from Lilly Endowment

ABHMS is strengthening its support for Latino/a clergy, lay leaders, and congregations across the United States and Puerto Rico, a commitment made possible by a \$1.5 million, five-year grant from Lilly Endowment Inc. through its National Initiative to Strengthen Hispanic Pastoral Leaders and Congregations. The award will fund ABHMS' new program, "Creciendo Juntos" (Growing Together).

Creciendo Juntos builds on ABHMS' research into the needs of Latino/a faith communities, identifying key areas where expanded resources and leadership development are most critical. The program has two main components: first, enhancing ABHMS' Latino Ministries through bilingual infrastructure and staff development, and second, establishing the Latino Leadership Program, designed to prepare and equip new and emerging church leaders. With an emphasis on practical development, participants will engage in skills-based courses, leadership formation experiences, and an innovation lab through ABHMS' Intercultural Leadership Institute and "Conferencia de Liderazgo Intergeneracional" (Intergenerational Leadership Conference).

"ABHMS wants to build trust with our Latino constituency by showing that we have truly heard and internalized their needs," said the Rev. Abner Cotto Bonilla, national coordinator, Latino Ministries. Discipleship Summit 2024: Engaging Young Adult Faith

In October, one of CCL's offerings included "Discipleship Summit 2024: Engaging Young Adult Faith," an online course designed to help churches, parents, and others passionate about working with young adults better understand and engage with them in today's rapidly evolving spiritual landscape.

The event was led by the Rev. Chuck Hunt, D.Min., senior director of training at Fuller Youth Institute. Informed by over 30 years of experience in ministry, particularly working with adolescents, young adults, and families, his talk focused on the latest research from Fuller Youth Institute regarding young adults' spiritual journeys and needs.

ABHMS Scholars and Summer Passionary interns who attended the event gave other participants invaluable insights into better walking alongside young adults in their congregations.

By building the summit around a panel discussion featuring younger voices, this interactive online course delivered a paradigm shift, from talking about young adults to talking with them. The Rev. Rebecca Irwin-Diehl, Ph.D., director of the CCL, explained: "Our goal is to explore new ways of engaging in meaningful dialogue, essentially creating spaces where young adults feel heard, valued, and genuinely connected to their faith communities."

Webinar series on mental well-being in Asian American congregations and communities

The Center for Continuous Learning offered many valuable webinars, including "Love the Lord with All Your Mind," aimed at Asian American faith leaders. This three-part webinar series, which began in January, was designed to facilitate dialogue about mental health with faith leaders who are themselves Asian American or who serve in congregations and communities with a significant Asian American presence.

In the initial session, "Seeking Wellness in Asian American Communities," scholar and clinician Dr. Jessica ChenFeng focused on better understanding mental well-being within the Asian American diaspora.

The second session, "Supporting Asian American Youth and Young Adults," explored ways of supporting youth and young adults who exhibit signs of mental distress. The Rev. Jason Ashimoto and Grace Yoshimoto from Evergreen Baptist Church of Los Angeles led the discussion.

The concluding session, "Serving as Trauma-Informed Leaders in Asian American Communities," was led by licensed therapist Tansy Kadoe and the Rev. Dr. Sanghoon Yoo, MSW. They discussed how to serve especially vulnerable populations with awareness and care.

The Rev. Michele Turek, national coordinator for Asian Ministries, believes that the series offers a solution for churches in the Asian American community that involves adopting a more holistic approach to achieving well-being. "Matthew instructs us to love God 'with all our minds,'" she said. "The mind is part of the whole person and, as such, is a fundamental part of the whole of what we bring to God." Turek asserts that a state of positive mental health should be sought as avidly as sound spiritual and physical health. This webinar came to fruition because we can no longer abide the silent suffering," she said.

Equipping clergy for effective ministry in diverse settings

Also in October, CCL hosted “Intercultural Preaching: The Preacher & the Praxis,” a two-hour hybrid workshop designed to equip participants for work in racially and ethnically diverse contexts. Sponsored by Intercultural Ministries, it was led by the Rev. Dr. Zina Jacque, renowned for her dedication to fostering communities of inclusion. Through her leadership in initiatives such as Courageous Conversations, she has demonstrated her dedication to addressing the challenges of a polarized world.

The workshop aimed at those who serve diverse congregations or regularly engage in guest preaching across various racial or cultural settings. It sought to enhance their preaching practices and deepen their impact. The event offered engaging, practical tools and resources to support effective intercultural preaching, such as video analysis of sermons delivered by individuals from different cultural backgrounds. Participants were invited to craft personal goals and practical strategies to advance them.

Technology and online resources help ministry professionals excel

The ministrElife team continued to develop and implement the new version of ministrElife, focusing on version two while maintaining version one. The new platform has technical and programmatic components, with the programmatic side targeting the core audience, particularly church staff. The team aims to grow the audience on social media platforms like Facebook, Blue Sky, and Instagram.

One of the big challenges is that there is no accurate database of all American Baptist ministry professionals. “I have worked on leveraging our relationships with the regions to get the most up-to-date directories, in addition to going to all of the individual churches, websites, Facebook pages, all social media, to identify as many of their ministry professionals as possible,” explained the Rev. Erica Van Brakle, ministrElife director of membership, content, and usage.

Efforts are underway to identify and profile ministry professionals, enhance interim ministry options, and improve data security. The platform aims to integrate various resources and communities, providing a secure, one-stop solution for ministry activities and enhancing collaboration and resource sharing among users. A mobile app is undergoing beta testing, with an imminent public release. Various groups and organizations are being onboarded onto the ministrElife platform to fulfill the vision of the platform becoming the digital home for communities and partnerships.

"It's just really about exposing listeners to different speakers because I think so often, we hear the same voices over and over that it's nice to hear different ones," said Biddle.

The 2024 speakers included the Rev. Tamara Jackson, director of the documentary "The Invitation" about women living with autoimmune diseases; the Rev. Dr. Kimberly Majeski, scholar, storyteller and activist who serves as executive

director of the non-profit Christian Women Connection; Ryan Taylor, the pastor of St. James Urban Church in Denver and the author of "Awkward Spirituality: The Divinity of Ordinary Life," and Rev. Dr. Michael Woolf, the senior minister of Lake Street Church of Evanston and the author of the book "Sanctuary and Subjectivity: Thinking Theologically about Whiteness and Sanctuary Movements."

Ahead of Space for Grace 2024, Biddle also interviewed workshop leaders: the Rev. Dr. Sarah Drummond, Min. Matthew Rivera, and the Rev. Breen Sipes.

Resources for Good

A church in Phoenix, Arizona, assists refugees with the help of an ABHMS grant

Since 2018, Monte Vista Cross Cultural Church in Phoenix has been doing God’s work for some of society’s most vulnerable members. Inspired by the Good Samaritan parable, they have served undocumented immigrants and asylum seekers who have been released from ICE custody. By providing food, clothing, and shelter, they bring the light of hope to those they serve.

Welcoming large groups into the church requires substantial resources: food, clothing, water, electricity, and transportation. When the church’s old shower trailer—essential for hygiene and sanitation—broke down, an Immigration and Refugee Grant covered the costs of plumbing and electrical work. That was vital, as the ability to shower after a long time in unsanitary conditions “makes the new arrivals feel like their humanity is restored,” said Ángel Campos,

senior pastor at MVCC. The need continues to be great. “When a crisis comes, it requires your attention, and it doesn’t let you know beforehand that it’s coming,” added Campos.

ABHMS grant fuels ESL classes, community gatherings to empower families in Chicagoland

An ABHMS grant has supported a multifaceted program to aid the families of underprivileged students in Warrenville, Illinois. In addition to ESL classes for parents, the program provides monthly community dinners where families can get together and build relationships with one another, the school, and social service workers.

Clifford A. Johnson Elementary School is a “high needs” school—students represent over 35 ethnicities. Their needs vary, but common threads in conversations with their parents include financial literacy, ESL literacy, and snack programs for the kids. Recognizing this, Warrenville Persons in Ministry (WPIM), an ecumenical association of ordained and lay leaders in Warrenville who have been collaborating on social justice issues for over 40 years, created a task force to assist Johnson School. The Rev. Frank Walton,

intentional interim pastor of Community Baptist Church Warrenville, is on the task force. “We were meeting monthly with the school’s principal, assistant principal, and social worker to figure out how we can better connect with the families at Johnson School,” said Walton.

They decided to start with relationship building by hosting a monthly dinner at the school, with the churches rotating meal preparation duties for gatherings that now regularly attract about 300 people every third Thursday. The main benefit of the dinner series is that it facilitates connections among the parents to build a strong, more resilient community. Thanks to the ABHMS grant, monthly dinners, the ESL, financial literacy, Internet safety, and parenting skills classes will be offered throughout 2025.






2024 contributions sources

Common Investment Fund

As a faith-based organization, American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS) affirms a powerful truth: faithful financial stewardship is a sacred form of ministry. For more than fifty years, ABHMS has embraced socially responsible investing (SRI) as a means of sustaining its missional programming and a profound expression of prophetic witness in today's world.

This deep commitment is embodied in the Common Investment Fund (CIF). Established in 1962 to manage ABHMS' investments and later expanded to welcome participation from American Baptist churches and affiliated institutions, the CIF is actively and prayerfully managed to generate attractive returns while investing

in companies consistent with our core values. As per this strategy, we try to avoid companies in industries that cause harm, such as tobacco, pornography, gambling, militarism, and alcohol. We also engage companies directly to encourage more just and ethical practices.

In partnership with the Interfaith Center for Corporate Responsibility (ICCR) and Investor Advocates for Social Justice (IASJ), ABHMS made meaningful progress in 2024 on key justice concerns, demonstrating that advocacy rooted in faith and compassion can move mountains.

Highlights of 2024 shareholder engagements

- **Microsoft:** ABHMS participated in a thoughtful, ongoing dialogue with Microsoft regarding human rights due diligence. The conversations centered on the company's evolving responsibilities in an era shaped by AI and cloud technology, particularly when police and military forces worldwide use these tools.
- **Amazon:** ABHMS submitted a shareholder proposal calling for greater transparency and accountability regarding surveillance and facial recognition technologies. Although the proposal received 17% support, less than in previous years and not eligible for resubmission, ABHMS remains steadfast in its advocacy alongside trusted partners.
- **The Hershey Co. & Tyson Foods:** ABHMS called on both companies to increase transparency by disclosing voting results by share class. Such disclosure would clarify whether shareholders with fewer voting rights—often the independent and values-driven ones—share concerns around issues like child labor and human rights due diligence.
- **Chevron:** A proposal submitted by ABHMS, requesting a third-party review and report on Chevron's implementation of its Human Rights Policy, received 22% support, the highest among all proposals on the company's 2024 ballot. This milestone reflects growing shareholder concern for corporate responsibility in human rights matters.
- **Mission-Directed Fund:** ABHMS' \$2 million Mission-Directed Fund continued to make a tangible impact by supporting initiatives focused on racial justice, access to capital for underserved communities, and environmental justice.


