Now That I Have My ABPS Profile, What Do I Do?

- 1. Keep your original Profile.
- Make copies of your Profile to be sent to region staff. Send a copy to executive ministers or area ministers where you are interested in being considered for a position.
- Consult the Ministry Opportunities Listing (MOL) to learn where there are churches
 and institutions looking for leadership. The name of the contact person is important,
 if not for the situation listed, perhaps for another place that would be better for you.
- 4. Write a cover letter indicating your interest in a particular situation and enclose the ABPS Profile.
- Follow up this letter with a phone call in a week to ten days. This call confirms how serious you are in your request. It also is an excellent way to establish contact with region staff.
- 6. Stay in touch with the region staff where you are located, as well as where your roots are. These men and women can give counsel and information that is useful as you seek a ministry position.
- 7. Drop a brief note to all those with whom you have been in touch when you accept a position. This is a thoughtful and considerate act.
