

Biblical reflection

"I will praise you and testify about what you have done." PSALM 22:22

To be certain, this verse is not a line that appears to us from some detached dimension or reality. One cannot lift this passage of affirmation out of its context of human suffering and pain, both internal and existential. This particular verse is the voice of a determined and resolute spirit, a resounding affirmation of one's internal determination to embody gratitude for the God who has brought the writer from the very edges of loneliness and pain.

There is no question that the soul is in crisis, deeply troubled. The psalmist describes the present circumstance as surrounded by dogs, facing the mouths of lions and gored by the horns of wild oxen (Psalm 22:16-21).



In this turmoil and struggle, we are confused by the clear and sudden affirmation of verse 22. What is the spirit of this verse? Is it resolve or a feigned bartering with God? How many times have we, during moments of intense resident pain, promised God, "If you get me out of this, I will do that"?

In reading through the entire Psalm, one cannot deny that verse 22 is a pivotal moment of transition from the wallowing self-pity of pain to the resolution of witness and testimony. This story is part of the witness of a God who is bringing us out and bringing us into something grander and more glorious than the tumult we presently experience.

We know this all too well. This difficulty has been our circumstance for the past 20 months. We are trying to figure out whether we stay paralyzed and isolated by the devastation brought on by a global health crisis; national (global) reckoning with the history of race and racism; the awareness of the prevalence of trauma-induced mental illnesses; and the connection between all three.

For God did not despise or abhor the affliction of the afflicted; he did not hide his face from me, but heard when I cried to him.

-Psalm 22:24

Such is the resolve of our efforts with the America for Christ Offering. We do not conclude that because there is pain and suffering, God is angered with us or our affliction. God does not turn away from communal and global crises, nor does God disperse blame on the victims for their corporate and collective troubles. Instead, God takes those opportunities to reveal God's face of compassion and an ear of empathy to our cries.


God shows God's face and affirms the devastation of our circumstances by providing resources that we cannot see because of our pain. Friends who we have not met and may never meet are dispatched to our rescue with resources from the very hand and heart of God. Experiencing God's hesed (undying steadfast love), we decree, "I will be a witness myself. I will tell of your name in the great congregation! I will praise you!"







What is the AFC 2022 theme?

The theme for the AFC 2022 Offering is "Testimony" based on Psalm 22:22: "I will praise you and testify about what you have done."

How can I support AFC 2022?

You can give during the congregational offering Sunday at your church, or you can give an individual gift online by visiting abhms.org/AFCnow. Also, consider encouraging your congregation's Mission Committee to include an America for Christ Offering contribution in its annual budget.
