Life and Transformation Continue

When Monique Sadler-Taylor's former husband Eric, the father of her children, died from COVID-19 in April 2021, she was left to pick up the pieces—literally and figuratively. She spent most of the spring and summer handling “all of the business of death while grieving and helping her children adjust.” Part of the “business” included preparing and selling their family home. Sadler-Taylor says, “It was a very difficult process, packing up a lifetime and letting things go. There were so many great times and happy memories wrapped up in that house.”


A visible representation of those happy memories was a cherry blossom tree she and her husband had planted in the front yard of their home 20 years ago. It grew to be very large and had significant meaning because it bloomed every year around their son's birthday in late March.

By September 2021, the cherry tree had no blooms but still had many green leaves—that is until the day the family arrived to move their belongings out of the house. “I was startled to discover that overnight all of its leaves had fallen,” recalls Sadler-Taylor. “No strong wind had blown through, and the neighbors' trees were still lush and green, but the cherry tree was completely bare, like it was the middle of winter.”

She says, “I couldn't believe my eyes and was struck with grief in that moment, but then, I received the message, ‘It is finished.’ This season and chapter of our lives was complete.” Sadler-Taylor thought about the fall and how leaves represent letting go—which is exactly what she and her children were learning to do. She found comfort in knowing that the tree wasn't dead, only dormant and resting, that life and transformation continued within its branches and that in the spring, it would bloom again. “I was reminded of the Resurrection and felt so much comfort in that moment, knowing that Eric isn't really gone either.”

As American Baptist Home Mission Societies' (ABHMS) director of the Annual Fund and Major Gifts, Sadler-Taylor sees a connection between her personal season of change and that of the organization. “While it may have appeared that we were in a crisis-imposed state of dormancy in 2021, in reality there was much taking place below the surface.”

Join us as we look inward and forward at how ABHMS—demonstrating incredible resilience—continued to shine a light in a dark time through mission engagement and mission giving.

Redefining Ministry Programs and Opportunities

Though the pandemic will be remembered for all that it took from the collective “us,” it did provide ABHMS with a season of discovery in which to cast a vision for the organization’s newly defined Practices in Mission and Ministry (Practices). “The goal in establishing these Practices,” said ABHMS Executive Director Dr. Jeffrey Haggray, “is to invite our constituents to explore ministry programs and opportunities that best suit how they want to learn and engage.” Whether seeking in-person mission experiences, skill-building educational opportunities, models and ideas for children’s programming, or strategies for local partnerships and networks, ABHMS programs and resources will help to broaden and build mission.

The four Practices clusters—Children, Youth and Young Adults; Leader Training and Education;

Experiential Learning; and Network and Capacity Building—build on ABHMS’ strengths in leadership development, discipleship, intercultural ministries, and healing and transforming communities. They also are rooted in ABHMS’ five missiological priorities: innovation and connecting people, exploring lifelong Christian faith formation, taking collaborative action on societal and missional issues, cultivating diverse leaders to address systemic injustice, and nurturing partnerships to eradicate racism and foster intercultural engagement.

ABHMS also strives to incorporate theological reflection and best-practice trends in programming into the Practices. The result is innovative programs that provide practical tools, connect our partners, and strengthen partners’ organizational capacities for sustainability and growth.



Children, Youth and Young Adults

Invest in and provide collaborative opportunities for children, youth and young adults to heal, learn, grow and become agents of transformation in their communities as they journey with Jesus Christ.

Leader Training and Education

Offer spiritually rooted education and training programs that are practically applied, culturally responsive and relevant to the real world, and provide a mutuality of exchange in which both facilitator and learner bring wisdom and passion for learning.



Experiential Learning

Develop fully committed followers of Jesus Christ who grow spiritually, provide valuable services to others in need, and create relationships through varied educational and hands-on mission experiences.

Network and Capacity Building

Strengthen partnerships, share resources, expand the capacity of local programs and develop leadership that impacts communities.





Practice Cluster: Children, Youth and Young Adults

ABHMS makes a difference in the lives of young people by engaging in educational networking and relationship-building activities with partners who share similar goals. We are passionate about enriching the physical, emotional, intellectual and spiritual health of America’s youth to advance their opportunities for future success. By improving the lives of children in their formative years, we enhance their chances of lifelong well-being.

Our learning environments and experiences engage children, youth, young adults and, sometimes, seniors in opportunities for service, healing, learning and living, where both young and old voices and perspectives are heard and valued. Authentic relation-

ship development provides opportunities for long-term mentorship, where mentors and mentees learn from one another and powerfully influence the next generation.

In July 2021, Cameron Community Ministries—a partner of ABHMS’ **Rizpah’s Children ministry**—engaged its children, staff and families in a learning and service opportunity when they participated in a National Day of Social Action. Through its Children’s Defense Fund Freedom School, supported by an ABHMS grant, the Rochester, N.Y., organization gathered a group of kindergartners through sixth grade students to design a banner and participate in planning a march to raise awareness about issues

within the juvenile justice system. Four of the students wrote speeches, sharing what they have learned about youth justice and what changes they would like to see within the system.

“I had fun planning the march and learning about what youth justice means. We were marching to bring awareness for kids who have not been given a fair chance within the juvenile justice system,” said 10-year-old Luvazia Fultz, a fifth grader. “It is important because we are bringing awareness and protesting for change.”

The march, said Sarah Green, Cameron Community Ministries’ Youth Program director, “shows scholars that their voices matter and that they can make a difference and participate in an action bigger than themselves. It opens conversations about changes they wish to see in the world and encourages action in the community.”





Practice Cluster: Leader Training and Education

ABHMS Leader Training and Education programs offer ministry partners opportunities for learning to live and lead through multiple lenses—personal, pastoral and prophetic. Intergenerational, intercultural and experiential training events are delivered in individual, small-group and congregational/organizational formats. Engaging practical theology, participants build on their creativity and passions by discovering practical tools and resources for effective ministry.

Cultural competency is integral to ABHMS training events, ensuring opportunities for dialogue around uncomfortable issues that encourage participants to think outside the box and participate in ministry in new ways. The programs sharpen critical thinking skills and imagination—equipping leaders for transformational ministry in their churches and communities.

In 2021, one of ABHMS' most successful leader training programs was **Chaplaincy Skills for Community Ministry**. Developed by the Rev. Dr. Patricia

Murphy, BCC, ABHMS ecclesiastical endorser, Chaplaincy and Specialized Ministries, and taught by board-certified and endorsed chaplains, this practical six-week certificate course in chaplaincy skills is for community contexts, where a ministry of nonsectarian spiritual care is needed. Participants learn how to offer a ministry of presence that

honors ecumenical and interfaith engagement, demonstrates cultural humility, practices refined listening skills, and responds to trauma with sensitivity and accountability.

Intended for individuals who are exploring a call to chaplaincy or those who are already providing

community support, the program's first cohort of 55 pastors, regional executives, lay leaders, clergy, chaplains and deacons graduated on November 15, 2021. In addition to the program content, the graduates also enjoy valuable benefits, including new associate endorsement through ABHMS, a six-month membership in the American Baptist National Network for Chaplains, Pastoral Counselors and Specialized Ministers, and participation in the active networking community on ABHMS' ministrElife online platform.

Growing Success Throughout the Year

In March 2021, ABHMS' **Co-Creators Incubator** introduced its second cohort of six individuals seeking to turn their Christ-centered ideas into viable ventures through the two-year program (top photo). In October, the group arrived at ABHMS' Leadership and Mission Building (LAMB) in King of Prussia, Pa., to pitch their unique visions to an audience via livestream (second photo from top).

In June 2021, **CeCaLi XXI**—Centro de Capacitación para Líderes del Siglo XXI—a program of ABHMS' Latino Ministries, introduced its Church Leadership Development summer and fall virtual workshops presented through ABHMS' Center for Continuous Learning (third photo from top). Delivered completely in Spanish, CeCaLi explores emerging issues in ministry, congregational life and pastoral practice, and offers practical tools, resources and coaching to fuel ministry.

In November 2021, 46 participants visited the LAMB for the 2021-2022 **Intercultural Leadership Institute**, which featured the Rev. Dr. Miguel A. De La Torre, professor of Social Ethics and Latinx Studies at the Iliff School of Theology, Denver, Colo. (bottom photo). The three-day event was the first meeting of the institute's second cohort, which equipped participants, who were from 18 states and Puerto Rico, with the theological and biblical foundation for intercultural ministries.





Practice Cluster: Experiential Learning

Utilizing training modules and speakers, immersion experiences and reflection, Experiential Learning programs:

- Offer leadership development and mentoring;
- Inspire the passionary journey from supporter to volunteer and leader;
- Provide diverse opportunities for developing cultural competency; and
- Transform the places where volunteers serve and change lives.

Each ABHMS experiential learning mission opportunity broadens the meaning of mission and includes an intercultural learning component. What's more, programs are designed for learning to continue beyond the mission event in ways that deepen spiritual formation.

While the pandemic curtailed most of ABHMS' experiential learning opportunities in 2021, progress was made in on-going efforts around Rebuilding,



Restoring, Renewing Puerto Rico. This initiative, which is working toward repairing 300 houses by the end of 2022, also supports the emotional and spiritual recovery of our brothers and sisters on the island. That kind of ministry can take many shapes

and forms, including a garden that is feeding the people of Puerto Rico with fresh, nutritious and delicious produce.

Facilitated by ABHMS' Intercultural Ministries Strategist Abigail Medina Betancourt, a garden on the grounds of the Ruth Maldonado Retreat Center is providing three kinds of lettuce, coriander, cilantro, cabbage, eggplant, peppers, sweet peppers,

tomatoes, corn and carrots to island residents who are still struggling in the wake of Hurricane Maria more than four years ago.

In addition, the garden at the retreat center—where volunteers reside during restoration projects—features eight benches, a plant nursery and 20 fruit trees, including tangerine and papaya. Desde mi Huerto Inc. provided training in building and maintaining the garden, preparing seedbeds and compost, controlling pests and creating fertilizer. Seven volunteers from six churches planted the garden and are harvesting its yield.

“In a country where the majority of our goods are imported, this project is vital because it will help us to promote self-sustainability, and we will be less dependent in case of any disaster in the future,” said Medina Betancourt.

ABHMS Leads First Mission Trip Since Pandemic's Start

With pre-purchased airline tickets that were set to expire at year's end, more than a dozen volunteers traveled to Puerto Rico in November on an ABHMS-led mission trip. It was the first such trip since the COVID-19 pandemic was declared in March 2020.

Ranging in age from their 20s into their 60s, 16 individuals from the American Baptist Churches of New Jersey region worked at two homes in addition to Iglesia Bautista de Quebrada and Corporación Milagros del Amor (CorMA), a partner of ABHMS' Community Outreach Ministries.

Practice Cluster: Network and Capacity Building

Network and Capacity Building programs—in which partners learn from one another, create new relationships and discover new resources—feature learning environments that encourage meaningful and healthy lifelong connections. Designed to adapt to various contexts, these experiences place high value on storytelling and story listening across cultures, generations and life experience.

Action and reflection are critical components of each experience, developed according to best practices and new models of learning. Offering opportunities and tools for experimenting, the programs feature diverse skill sets and perspectives, along with shared leadership models to inspire collective action.

ABHMS' **Justice Dialogues** embody the discovery, learning and relationship building that are inherent in Network and Capacity Building programs. As forums for open discussion, reflection



and encouragement, the dialogues bring together those who are in the work of healing and transforming communities and systems.

In 2021, Justice Dialogues addressed:

- Christians Rebuilding Democracy, with the Rev. Adam Russell Taylor, president of Sojourners;
- Voices of Faith within Community, with the Rev. Laura Ayala, senior pastor of Primera Iglesia Bautista de Rio Piedras, San Juan, Puerto Rico; and
- Faith, Hope, Love and Mental Health, with the Rev. Jermaine Alberty, executive director of Pathways to Promise.

ABHMS will continue to convene Justice Dialogues as a safe and brave space for activists and advocates to be in community with each other, tell our stories, receive encouragement, provide updates and offer prayers that fortify our work together.

Growing Ever Stronger

Network and Capacity Building exhibited signs of increasing vigor in 2021, including:

An on-site and virtual celebration and soft launch for ABHMS' **National Network of American Baptist Chaplains, Pastoral Counselors, Spiritual Directors and Specialized Ministers** in November. Composed of individuals who support the mission of ABHMS in a wide array of capacities, this professional support and networking organization is now more than 200 strong.

Two virtual **Converge Consultations for Palmer Grant Recipients** hosted by ABHMS. At the first consultation, participants worshipped and networked with one another. They also received practical training on how to make a compelling 90-second pitch to donors. The keynote speaker for the second consultation was Joy Anderson, who works at the intersection of finance and social change as founder and president of the Criterion Group. She spoke about how nonprofits can think more creatively about finance and weave it into their work.

Grants from ABHMS' **Louise Burchard Pierce Memorial Fund** supported multiple worthy causes. An award to the Education Lab at First Baptist Church of Cooperstown, N.Y., is directly impacting the "educational success of students who are receiving tutoring services," according to Cynthia Falk, Ph.D., a church member who was



instrumental in securing the grant. In her capacity as a congregational lay leader and special assistant with American Baptist Churches' International Ministries, Dr. Falk also helped to obtain funding for an immigration and family legal assistance clinical program. Intended for migrant farm workers affected by unsettled U.S. immigration policies, the program was made possible through a partnership with Cornell Law School.

Center for Continuous Learning

One of the highlights of 2021 was the soft launch of ABHMS' Center for Continuous Learning (CCL) during June's virtual Biennial Mission Summit.

Introducing the center was its founding director, the Rev. Rebecca Irwin-Diehl, who formerly served as Judson Press' long-time editor. Irwin-Diehl acknowledged the impact of the pandemic on the launch but was delighted with ABHMS' resilience and ability to pivot at this critical time: "The foundational vision for CCL is that it is a physical facility located in our Leadership and Mission Building (LAMB) in King of Prussia, but the pandemic gave us both the opportunity and the challenge to accelerate the development of an online learning system."

CCL is a hub for practical mission education, committed to empowering God's people for today's

real-life challenges. Seeking to equip leaders as disciples, to make disciples into leaders, and to train God's people to fulfill their ministry passions, CCL features interactive, intercultural and incarnational learning experiences that respond to current trends in leadership training, critically engage the cultural moment for healing and justice, and intentionally innovate mission education with emerging generations.

"The Center for Continuous Learning offers exciting opportunities to deliver quality ABHMS training and education in new and dynamic ways," said Irwin-Diehl. "The website—ccl.ministrelife.org—is a powerful learning platform that can host live events, on-demand webinars and cohort-based trainings."

In September 2021, CCL's bricks-and-mortar home in the LAMB was dedicated as the new Dr. Aidsand F. Wright-Riggins III Learning Center in honor of the ABHMS executive director emeritus who led the organization for 24 years, the longest continuous leadership tenure in ABHMS history.

CCL Ramps Up Programming

In 2021, CCL expanded its program portfolio, which included:

ABHMS' **Discipleship Summit** featured author and pastor Michael Adam Beck, a leading voice in teaching churches a model for thriving in the midst of overwhelming cultural change.

A free "**Savvy Student Loan Management**" seminar with student loan expert Heather Jarvis, was supported by a grant from the Lilly Endowment Inc.

A live "**Leading Out of Crisis**" webinar with Alan Roxburgh, founder of The Missional Network (TMN) and Sara Jane Walker, president of TMN, was followed by a six-week "**Leading Out of COVID**" online training.

CeCaLi XXI, a Spanish-language leadership training for those in pastoral ministry, was offered as a four-part series.

An online training hosted by ABHMS' Intercultural Ministries, "**Trauma and Healing in Wounded Communities**" equipped pastors and lay leaders with tools to heal ministries by serving people, especially in multicultural communities, who have experienced trauma.

A four-week virtual program "**Journeys through Advent: An Online Bible Study**" was facilitated by May May Latt of the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago and the Rev. Dr. Michael Woolf, senior minister, Lake Street Church of Evanston, Ill., writers of the "Sundays in Advent" sessions in Judson Press' *Journeys*.

"**Starting the Money Conversation**," a webinar training series around common money issues, including resolving debt, understanding and using credit, and saving toward goals, delivered by experts from the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau.

Judson Press Welcomes New Publisher, the Rev. Dr. Cheryl Price

After serving as the ABHMS publishing ministry's senior editor, in September 2021 the Rev. Dr. Cheryl Price was officially named Judson Press publisher. Dr. Price said her goals are to "create an opportunity for writers to discuss their book ideas; invite more authors with multiple abilities; provide more books and resources regarding the environment, climate control, clean food and water; and continue to address such challenges as racism, sexism and economic exploitation."

Commenting on her appointment, Dr. Jeffrey Haggray, CEO of Judson Press, noted that Dr. Price

will lead the publisher's repositioning strategy as the bicentennial of this venerable Christian ministry approaches in 2024. "She integrates a strong background in the publishing profession with practical ministry in the church, teaching experience in the academy and a passion for reading," he said.

Well-qualified for this ministry, Dr. Price previously served as vice president of content at Urban Ministries Inc., Calumet City, Ill.; and minister on staff at Metropolitan Baptist Church, Washington, D.C.; Mount Zion Baptist Church, Seattle, Wash.; and at Lutheran and United Methodist congregations in New York and California. She has authored and co-authored several books.

With Liberty and Justice for Some: The Bible, the Constitution and Racism in America, by Susan K. Lifting Women in Ministry Beyond the Stained-Glass Ceiling

The 2021 “Beyond the Stained-Glass Ceiling” grants were awarded to co-preachers the Rev. Kamilah Hall Sharp and the Rev. Dr. Irie Lynne Session of The Gathering: A Womanist Church, Dallas, and Dr. Carol M. Garrett of the Historic Parsells Church, Rochester, N.Y.

The grants originated with the Rev. Chris Smith, pastor of Restoration Ministries of Greater Cleveland Inc., who established an endowed gift with ABHMS that supports at least two African American female pastors yearly who serve congregations of 300 or fewer members.

African American women in ministry are often called to economically depressed, small churches that are unable to pay a living wage. The Beyond the Stained-Glass Ceiling Endowment Fund helps ABHMS to support, encourage and advocate for the well-being of Black and African American female pastoral leaders by helping to alleviate the economic challenges and related stress they face. It helps to ensure that those who are called to serve are equipped to serve.



One Great Hour of Sharing Provides Funds for Tornado Victims



In late 2021, on behalf of American Baptist Churches USA, ABHMS released \$7,500 in One Great Hour of Sharing disaster-relief funds to American Baptist Churches of Indiana and Kentucky in response to December’s catastrophic tornadoes.

At least 38 tornadoes caused significant damage and tragic loss of life in Arkansas, Mississippi, Missouri, Kentucky, Tennessee and Illinois.

“The grant will enable us to partner with our member churches to provide direct relief to those affected by the recent outbreak of tornadoes in Kentucky,” wrote the Rev. James Walter, the region’s then-interim executive minister. “We will partner with congregations as they seek to provide help at this time.”






2021 Contributions Sources

Common Investment Fund

Socially responsible investing (SRI) is a hallmark of American Baptist Home Mission Societies' Common Investment Fund (CIF). Through SRI, the CIF seeks not only to maximize financial returns, but also to leverage ABHMS' power as a shareholder to encourage corporations in which ABHMS is invested to engage in just and equitable business practices related to social and environmental issues. The COVID-19 pandemic's impact on health and worker human rights reemphasized the importance of our SRI advocacy.

ABHMS' priority SRI issues include affordable drug pricing, human rights, climate change, environmental justice, water stewardship and

responsible financial practices. Corporate engagement around these issues is planned annually in collaboration with ABHMS' Socially Responsible Investment Advisory Council and our SRI consultant—Investor Advocates for Social Justice.

In 2021—in partnership with members of the Interfaith Center for Corporate Responsibility—



ABHMS pressed companies, such as Tyson Foods, The Hershey Co., Pfizer, and Amazon to improve management of environmental, social and governance risks.

Highlights of 2021 Shareholder Engagements

- ABHMS continued to engage with Tyson Foods, prioritizing human rights issues. Ongoing shareholder pressure, including a 2021 proposal led by ABHMS, has won unprecedented support for reforms of the company's human rights practices. This engagement called attention to dangerous worker health and safety conditions in Tyson facilities during COVID-19, and the shareholder proposal filed by ABHMS received independent shareholder support of an unprecedented 78.7%. Future dialogue will consider a racial equity audit.
- ABHMS continued to lead dialogues with The Hershey Co. on human rights and sustainable agriculture, focused on child labor in the cocoa supply chain. ABHMS urged the company to implement the Human Rights Policy adopted in 2020 and to consider a living wage for its workers.
- With support from Investors for Opioid Accountability, ABHMS co-filed a Pfizer shareholder proposal calling for an independent chair to strengthen governance and oversight of risks related to the opioid crisis. Dialogue also included fair COVID-19 vaccine access to underserved communities.
- ABHMS co-filed an Amazon shareholder proposal on issues related to surveillance, privacy and racial justice associated with facial recognition and surveillance technologies and government relationships.
- ABHMS continued its SRI impact priority strategy for the \$2 million Socially Responsible Mission Directed Fund. Priority areas include investing in regional focus areas (Puerto Rico and the Southeast United States), supporting racial justice, improving underserved groups' access to capital, promoting environmental justice and mitigating climate change, and supporting pastors. Investments were made in the following funds to further these goals: Boston Impact Initiative, Chicago Trend, Ignite Capital, Sustain VC: Impact Fund II, Resilient Ventures Fund I.L.P., and Climate Investment Solutions Fund.




