Leadership Empowerment

Co-Creators Incubator Cycle 3 Launch Summit

Ministry innovation continues to be one of the American Baptist Home Mission Societies' top priorities. Oct. 16-18, 2023, the Launch Summit of Co-Creators Incubator Cycle 3 culminated a year-long effort of the ministry innovators who participated in the Cycle 3 cohort. They presented their work and enjoyed opportunities to network and exchange experiences.

After an initial in-person gathering at ABHMS in January 2023 for the Co-Creators Kickoff Summit, the cohort convened online between then and

October 2023 to address topics related to business and professional entrepreneurship. During that time—the “incubation period”—cohort members developed an understanding of what they wanted to achieve, designed a business plan, and learned to tell their story in a compelling way to a wider

audience. Each Co-Creator receives seed funding of \$3,000 to launch their project.

At the summit, the Co-Creators pitched their projects to a panel of distinguished entrepreneurs, including the Rev. Amy Butler, founder of the nonprofit Invested Faith and former senior minister at the Riverside Church, New York, and Calvary Baptist Church in Washington, D.C.; Rasheed Abdellah, co-founder of Indie-Life, a creative agency special-

izing in branding, communications, events and production management; and Garry Mills, founder and executive director of the nonprofit Shoot Basketball NOT People.

The group, accompanied by ABHMS staff, also went on a field trip to see innovation in action. They visited RAWTools, a Philadelphia community whose mission is to get guns off the streets by melting them, and other weapons, to fashion garden tools.

The Rev. Dr. Lauren Ng, director of Leadership Empowerment at ABHMS and the Co-Creators Incubator program explained that the incubator provides program participants with a unique opportunity to interact with fellow entrepreneurs. “They’re not in traditional models of church,” said Ng. “They wake up every morning, often feeling like no one’s going to get this thing.”

“Being a part of the Co-Creators Incubator has saved me years of initial struggle in my ministry,” said Co-Creator Josh Richardson, executive director of Brugmansia Ministries, a nonprofit that helps faith organizations address local challenges related to global warming. “With the collaborative nature of this program, it has also helped evolve my ministry to be more focused and effective.”

Scholarship Recipients Meeting in August

Long recognizing the soaring costs of higher education, American Baptist Home Mission Societies has historically helped to support American Baptist students through its scholarship program. In 2023, ABHMS redoubled its effort to also start building a vibrant network of scholarship recipients who will eventually partner with ABHMS in other ways.

To this end, Alexzandria Sanchez, ABHMS national coordinator for Scholarships and Emerging Leaders, hosted a virtual gathering on Aug. 1 for more than 40 2023-2024 ABHMS scholarship recipients from across the United States and Puerto Rico.

“Our goal is to build a community of ABHMS scholars,” said Sanchez, “and this starts with creating

a space where scholarship recipients can get to know each other and be introduced to the rich opportunities that ABHMS has to offer for emerging leaders.”

Another such gathering is planned for 2024.

Daniel E. Weiss Scholarship

Jolly A. Guisti Santaella was the 2023 recipient of the Daniel E. Weiss Scholarship. In September, Guisti Santaella began the Master of Divinity program at Seminario Evangélico de Puerto Rico.

Currently in the pre-ministerial process to become an endorsed pastor in the Baptist Churches of Puerto Rico, Guisti Santaella said: “Since I was really young, I have been very passionate about serving. Generally, I love to just be of service to the people I know.”

Healing & Transforming Communities

Summer Passionary Institute

In the spirit of its missional commitment to cultivating leaders and equipping disciples, American Baptist Home Mission Societies launched its Summer Passionary Institute (SPI) in late May 2023. Over the subsequent 10 weeks, members of the inaugural cohort, young adults ages 18–29 hailing from across the United States and Puerto Rico, were immersed in their internships and encouraged to reflect deeply on their faith and futures.

The institute works with congregations, community ministries and nonprofit organizations focused on social justice, with participating passionaries interning with ABHMS partners located across the United States and Puerto Rico. Each passionary in the

first cohort was assigned to a specific site based on the individual's sense of calling to ministry and vocational interests. Throughout the duration of their internship experiences, the passionaries were coached by relevant professionals.

SPI is designed to facilitate deep conversational and reflective engagement around formative questions; connect the passionaries with experiences that align with their developing sense of life calling; and nurture empathy for those seeking to overcome challenging circumstances.

Passionary Amari Lockhart from Georgia said: "I will make a change in the world! Homelessness is one area I'd like to change. As Christians, we are supposed to love and take care of each other as Christ does for us."

Immediately after their orientation, the passionaries traveled to their respective worksites. Thereafter, they convened online weekly with different ABHMS program staff and ABHMS partners for facilitated conversations.

"We are cultivating these leaders with eight organizational partners with a 'win, win, win' in mind," said the Rev. Lisa Harris Lee, ABHMS director of Healing & Transforming Communities. "It's a win for the interns and for the organizations whose missions the interns are helping to advance. It's also a win for the communities these organizations serve because they see young adults with a heart to make meaningful impact."

Justice Dialogues

Food insecurity in a land of plenty, mental health in faith communities, and the conflict in the Middle East were among the topics of the Justice Dialogues ABHMS hosted in 2023, the fourth year of the program. Fulfilling the truth of the verse “But as for you, return to your God; hold fast to love and justice,” (Hosea 12:6). Justice Dialogues is a forum that offers American Baptists a chance to learn about global and national events from a faith perspective. The Justice Dialogues series provides informed opinion, a like-minded community, and a space where solutions to problems can be imagined and discussed.

Intercultural Ministries

A Fresh Start: Relationships are the Mission

For Intercultural Ministries (ICM), 2023 proved to be a year of reflection and recalibration under the guidance of its director, the Rev. Dr. Marie Onwubuariri, who assumed her role in late 2022. Unsatisfied with the status quo, Onwubuariri envisioned a revitalized ICM. She unleashed the program unit's national coordinators, some altogether new to ABHMS and others in newly redefined roles but all bursting with energy, to network and connect with, listen to and learn from ICM's constituencies to discern a new strategic path for ICM.

Work we do to listen/research what is most pressing among our constituency

The ICM team actively engaged current and potential partners and ministry leaders to identify mission and ministry passions, needs and synergies. Online listening sessions, personal conversations and a multi-day event at the LAMB were among the ways that ICM explored an array of topics such as ministry networking, relations between public K-12 education and the church, program assessment and development, and Bible study and corporate worship through an intercultural lens.

These efforts have informed ICM's programming for the next several years, which includes:

- Developing a three-year plan to guide the creation of a contextualized Christian education curriculum for the Haitian community.
- Equipping the Asian community to better manage mental health issues, minister to people with disabilities, and mobilize faith formation among youth and between generations and cultures.
- Strengthening the connections between Latino youth and the church, which involves closing the theological, cultural and philosophical gaps between generations.
- Building affinity between youth in the Native American community and the church with a new training series that prioritizes youth discipleship by properly developing, supporting and equipping youth leaders for their roles.

ICM hosted The Forum: An ABHMS Intercultural and Ethnic Ministries Exchange, convening attendees from across the United States and Puerto Rico at ABHMS' Leadership and Mission Building in April 2023 to gain insights about future ICM programming.

Work we do to prepare for intercultural engagement

Another ICM imperative coming out of 2023 is developing leaders who nurture intercultural engagement and can foster equitable and inclusive ministries. In November, a reconstituted Intercultural Leadership Institute (ILI) hosted a preview event featuring a rich variety of soon-to-be-available resources, including:

- A three-tiered education series designed to cultivate intercultural leadership skills and prepare leaders to become active members of the ABHMS ILI Consultancy Network.
- Communities of practice that feature facilitator-guided peer learning related to distinct types of intercultural leadership contexts.
- A bank of annotated digital media resources available to intercultural leaders via an online platform and a quarterly e-newsletter.
- A consultancy network of ILI-aligned trainers and facilitators.

Missional journeys to cultivate and nurture relationships

ICM took missional journeys in 2023 to connect with churches. For instance, an ABHMS delegation in December visited three partner churches and the Peace Academic Center located on the Hopi Reservation in Arizona. The Rev. Ben Sullivan, national coordinator for Native American Ministries, described the reservation as “an amazing place,” where members of the delegation found extraordinary grace and hospitality and instant friendship with those working in these ministries. What emerged from a stay, vowed Sullivan, “was a commitment to return to this land and bring our colleagues with us to work and learn among the Hopi once again.”



Biennial Mission Summit

Mission Project

Mission experiences are vital for faith and identity formation for many American Baptists who often become engaged in such work in their youth. In June, prior to the Biennial Mission Summit in San Juan, Puerto Rico, ABHMS coordinated the mission activity of a group of volunteers ages 18 to 76 over two days in Río Piedras, Caguas, and San Juan.

On June 21, the volunteers met at Primera Iglesia Bautista de Río Piedras to assemble 500 backpacks with school supplies for elementary school students and 250 hygiene supplies for unhoused persons. The next day, the team of 23 was divided, with half of the group headed for Iglesia Bautista de Altamesa in San Juan, and the other group working at the home of an elderly man in Caguas, about 30 minutes south of San Juan.

Those working at the church in Altamesa did some roof work, cleaned and painted the exterior of the church, which is an important community hub. “We exist to serve our community,” commented Pastora Migdalia Flores of the Altamesa church. “When a hurricane strikes, people come and sleep at our church, they feel safer here.”

Center for Continuous Learning

“Being Baptist: History, Identity & Polity”

“Being Baptist: History, Identity & Polity” is a flagship CCL offering. A synchronous, six-week certificate course, especially designed for those who are seeking an ordination in American Baptist Churches USA, it satisfies many regions’ Baptist polity requirement for ordination. The ABHMS’ offering is an accessible and affordable option for those whose seminaries or regions do not offer a similar course. It is also a great offering for Baptist history fans. In 2023, 24 students from 12 ABCUSA regions completed the course.

In 2023, students praised clear delivery, interesting assignments and a supportive community of learners. Learning about Baptist principles helped them understand how Baptists are distinctive from

other Protestant Christians. “Tremendously helpful,” wrote one participant. “Outstanding overview of all things Baptist,” wrote another.

The Rev. Diane Badger, coordinator for the Commission of Ordained Ministry of the American Baptist Churches of Massachusetts, took the pilot “Being Baptist” course in spring 2023 out of professional interest in Baptist history—she works on an archive of Massachusetts Baptists’ works—but also because she wanted to ascertain whether the course would be accepted by her region for ordination purposes. She said: “I thought that was really well done and valuable for people to know. They really brought forth the tenets of our faith in a constructive, thoughtful manner.”

“Why Sabbatical?”

The tradition of clergy taking a sabbatical is founded in recognition that ministry is a vocation that involves unusually high, persistent mental pressure and emotional rollercoasters. In winter 2023, CCL offered the first in the series of two interactive webinars titled “Why Sabbatical?” led by the Rev. Dr. Eugene Downing, pastor of the New Hope Baptist Church in Denver.

Rev. Downing specifies that pastoral burnout is characterized by “emotional exhaustion, low sense of personal accomplishment and a high degree of depersonalization.” It often goes unrecognized, and,

therefore, unaddressed. Downing talked about the importance of discerning one’s vision for the sabbatical; such a vision may involve a focus on personal identity, pastoral identity, or a “space to dream”; he reflected that sometimes, the pastoral identity can overshadow the personal one: individual preferences, pursuits, or engagements. Similarly, routine tasks of ministry may eclipse the need for strategic thinking about one’s ministry and simply dreaming of what God has in store for us. Sabbaticals offer people time that is free from restrictions of the everyday and space to think big. The results? Pastors return healed, reinvigorated, and full of ideas.

New website and new courses

Select live and on-demand learning experiences in 2023 included:

- Being Baptist: History, Identity & Polity, a six-week certificate course led by the Rev. Dr. Rebecca Irwin-Diehl.
- Foundations for Faithful Finance, a six-week live cohort course facilitated by Judson Press author Shayna Harvey.
- Discipleship Summit, a webinar replay exploring what it means to be Baptist today, led by the Rev. Joy Martinez-Marshall and the Rev. Don Ng.
- Asian Americans & Burma History, a webinar replay focused on immigration experiences and the impact of racism on Asian Americans facilitated by Dr. Russel Jeung.
- Let's Talk about Mental Health, a free on-demand course based on five interviews with licensed therapists and credentialed spiritual caregivers about issues such as grief and self-care.
- Intercambios sagrados (Spanish), a series of six videos that discuss a holistic model for stewardship and congregational vitality, led by the Rev. Walter Baires.

ministrElife

MinistrElife, an extension of American Baptist Personnel Services, is a virtual hub, or a social network, designed for all kinds of ministry professionals. Ordained clergy, chaplains, specialized ministers, church musicians, religious nonprofit executive directors, seminarians, or those discerning a call to ministry collectively form the ME community.

The 2.0 version of the platform is a major upgrade from the existing one in terms of functionality and ease of use.

2023 was a time of steady progress of ministrElife 2.0 platform development. Rev. Saeed Richardson, ABHMS' chief technology & information security officer, spent the year working with software developers building a whole new infrastructure system, including the ME desktop, web, and mobile apps. The individual profiles and ministry role advertisements will be integrated into a sophisticated recruitment and job matching system incorporated into their private social network, streamlining the hiring process.

"This is a custom-built environment," says Richardson, "and it is diametrically different from commercial, ad-driven social networks in three major ways: it is private, meaning the data about people will not be sold on to other entities; the community engagement functionality is of vital importance; con-

tent is ranked around a 'positivity sentiment score.'" These characteristics make the new platform unique and very safe to use.

Importantly, ultimately the ministrElife 2.0 platform is envisioned as an ecumenical, and even interfaith setting. "I think anybody who's engaging in ministry, whether that's a church, or another traditional kind of role, or a religious not-for-profit, will find this platform useful," commented the Rev. Erica Van Brakle, ministrElife director of membership, content, and usage. "We've built a place for the religious community to come together to have a conversation."

As the back-end work continued, the ministrElife team traveled the country to raise awareness of the new app. The Rev. Meg Biddle, national coordinator for leadership placement & networking on ministrElife, went to the 2023 Prairie Pastor's Conference in Omaha where she guided the attending clergy through the app's "roadmap" and answered questions. Biddle also promoted ministrElife at the Central Region's annual meeting in Lawrence, Kansas (where she was invited to preach at First Baptist Church Lawrence) and the Resource Leadership Conference sponsored by Judson University, the Great Rivers Region, and the Indiana & Kentucky region.

Ministry Mondays with Meg

The Rev. Meg Biddle created 30 episodes of Ministry Mondays with Meg in 2023. The podcast continues to demonstrate that ministry is not a calling that takes place exclusively within the walls of the church, but rather, always among those it serves. Among Meg's guests were ABC pastors, seminary faculty, ABHMS staff, nonprofit founders, regional staff, consultants, and Judson Press authors. Some of them included:

- Melinda Mitchell, who discussed her debut novel, "Next of Kin" (2023, Arus Entertainment), is also known as the Rev. Mindi Welton-Mitchell, executive minister of the American Baptist Churches of Wisconsin. The novel is a retelling of the story of Ruth in space.

- In the 50th episode of the podcast, the Rev. Dr. Eugene Downing talked about clergy burnout, self-care, and the importance of Sabbath and sabbaticals for ministry professionals. He led a two-part webinar series for the Center for Continuous Learning on this topic.

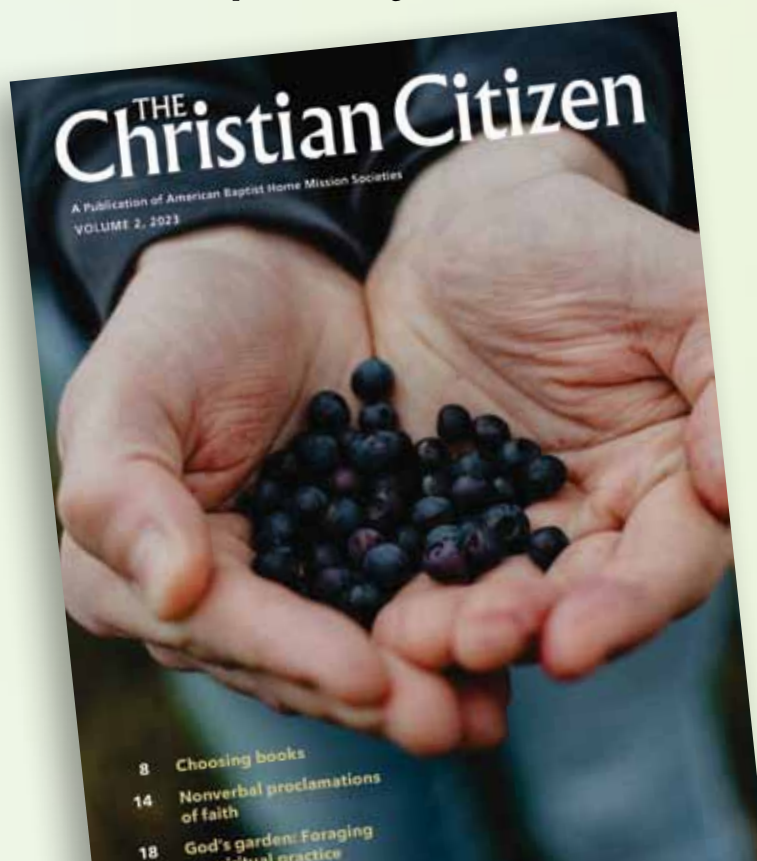

In 2023, The Christian Citizen published 179 articles online at christiancitizen.us. We also published 43 issues of our Christian Citizen Weekly newsletter and two print editions of the publication.

The Christian Citizen received a DeRose-Hinkhouse award from Religion Communicators Council for Volume 2, 2023. This issue was the category winner in the Magazine —Single Work category.

Christian Citizen editor, Curtis Ramsey-Lucas, received a Best-in-Class award, RCC's highest honor, for his article "Bruce Willis Diagnosed with FTD: How churches can respond pastorally to people with dementia," published by Baptist News Global. He received five other DeRose-Hinkhouse awards for articles published in The Christian Citizen and The Christian Century including, "Can an exhausted majority find hope in a campaign for dignity?," "When death interrupts life," and "Missionary of grief," a review of Nick Cave and Sean O'Hagan's "Faith, Hope and Carnage."

Resources for Good

ABHMS supports community building through a second grant to Sympara

As part of its mission to support the empowerment of Christian leaders as well as the healing and transforming of communities, in 2023, ABHMS awarded a grant to Sympara, Inc., (the second since 2020). Sympara, a nonprofit, works to repurpose church properties and sacred spaces for the common good.

Eager to leverage technology to connect community partners who wish to share their resources, Sympara used its first ABHMS grant to fund initial development of a mobile application. The more recent grant is going toward upgrades to the app to increase its functionality. This includes the addition of a Spanish-language version, story-mapping tools and collaboration features. The grant will also fund training for clergy and lay leaders to enhance their sacred and civic placemaking capacity and enable storytelling about the app's impact.

Identifying and connecting like-minded partners in the public service ecosystem can be a problem. Daniel Pryfogle, Sympara cofounder and CEO, was driven by his vision of interconnected, collaborative communities in his quest for a solution.

He is confident that the Sympara app when coupled with the broader principles of asset-based community development has the potential to strengthen the agency of local actors, be they individuals or organizations. In addition, the Sympara curriculum—co-created by ABHMS and Campbell University in Buies Creek, North Carolina—is expected to increase the number of communities that harness the connective power of the app and the resources that are its driving force.

ABHMS grant improves conditions for asylum seekers in Arizona

“When a crisis comes, it requires your attention, and it doesn’t let you know beforehand that it’s coming,” said Ángel Campos, senior pastor at Monte Vista Cross Cultural Church in Phoenix, when asked in December 2023 to describe the church’s Good Samaritan Project. His church has been helping migrants released from Immigration and Customs Enforcement custody since 2018.

“In 2018, in Phoenix, we started seeing a lot of these immigrants stranded in the bus station,” said Campos. “They were being released right there on the streets.” Today, Monte Vista Cross Cultural Church’s Good Samaritan Project employs four full-time staff and serves approximately 650 people weekly. In addition to providing food and shelter, Campos and staff help immigrants connect with their families throughout the U.S.

In 2022, Monte Vista was requested to increase its capacity from assisting 200 to 400 individuals per week. Welcoming large groups into the church requires substantial resources, including food, clothing, water, electricity and transportation. When the church’s old shower trailer—essential for hygiene and sanitation—required repairs, a grant from ABHMS paid for plumbing and electrical work. It also covered repairs on another trailer on loan to the church.

Monte Vista’s mission is to aid asylum seekers by recognizing their basic spiritual and material needs. It is guided by profound faith. Campos pointed to Jesus’ instruction in the Gospel of Matthew: feed the hungry, clothe the naked, host the homeless, help the helpless. Every day, crisis or not, Monte Vista Cross Cultural Church rises to the challenge.

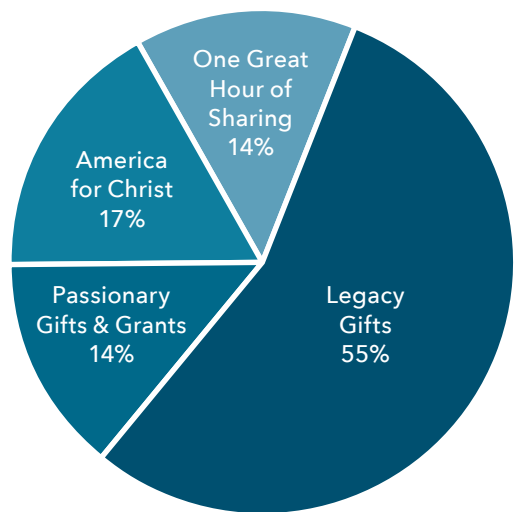

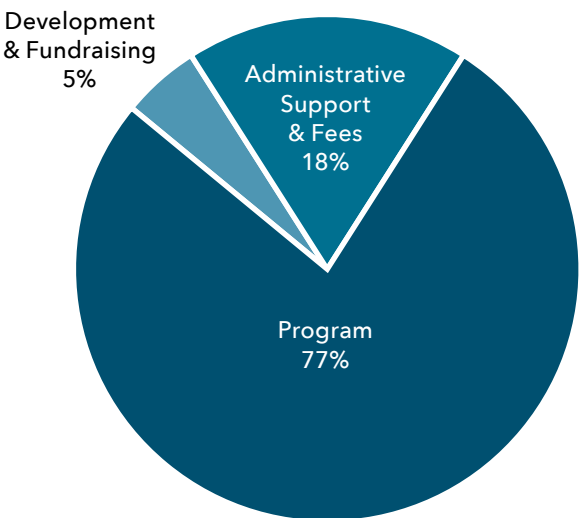

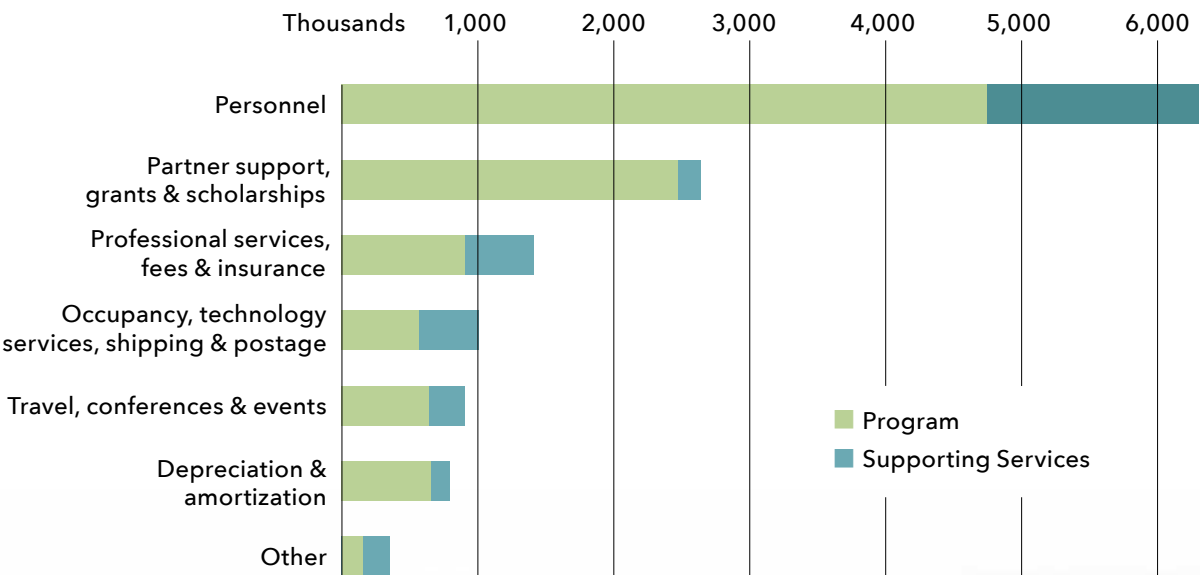
2023 Contributions sources

Common Investment Fund

Grounded in ABHMS' mission to, "heal and transform communities in partnership with American Baptists and others," the Common Investment Fund (CIF) serves not only to maximize financial returns but also exemplifies the influence shareholders can have collectively when joined together for a common cause. Working strategically with partners like the Interfaith Center for Corporate Responsibility (ICCR) and Investor Advocates for Social Justice (IASJ), ABHMS leverages its role as an investor to advocate on justice issues related to people and planet through socially responsible investment opportunities, often before those issues attract widespread national attention.

Investments in companies like Amazon, Hershey and Tyson give ABHMS a seat at the table and the

opportunity to lead or support advocacy efforts in areas ranging from child labor to disability rights to Indigenous peoples' rights. Working strategically with our partners also allows us to be on the ground floor of emerging justice issues such as human rights within the electric vehicle value chain.

In 2023, ABHMS, in partnership with the ICCR and IASJ, made significant headway on major justice issues through firm and consistent advocacy efforts.



Highlights of 2023 Shareholder Engagements

- ABHMS signed on to IASJ's Shifting Gears Campaign, which addresses human rights issues of forced labor, child labor and Indigenous peoples' rights focusing its advocacy efforts specifically on Ford, GM and Stellantis.
- Amazon: ABHMS filed a shareholder proposal requesting a report on customer due diligence on issues related to surveillance, privacy, and racial justice associated with facial recognition and surveillance technologies sold to governments and other agencies.
- DOW: A racial equity audit considering internal staff and external customers and suppliers was successfully advocated with support from ABHMS in 2023. The results are expected to be published in 2024.
- Hershey: ABHMS continues to lead dialogues with Hershey on human rights issues with a core focus on living income and child labor in the cocoa supply chain. ABHMS urges the company to implement the Human Rights Policy adopted in 2020 and to consider a living income for its cocoa workers.
- Tyson Foods: A shareholder proposal led by ABHMS in 2023 focusing on reforms for child labor and living income practices won unprecedented support from shareholders. This engagement called attention to child labor health and safety conditions in Tyson facilities. A racial equity audit is also in process.
- ABHMS' two-million-dollar Mission Directed Fund continued supporting efforts related to racial justice; access to capital for under-served groups, and environmental justice and climate change mitigation.

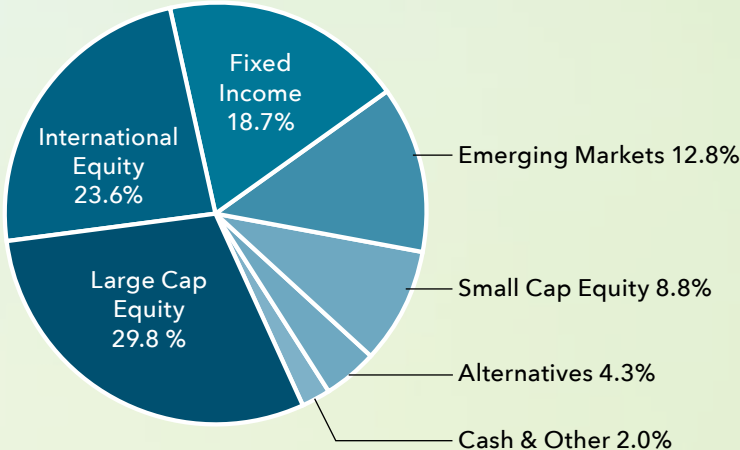

Office of Development

On an annual basis, ABHMS receives transformational gifts that make an immediate and lasting impact. Here are two stories of amazing generosity:

Wanda Bunce (1941–2021) and Richard Bunce (1945–2021) lived lives of faith, family and generosity.

Every December, Wanda and Richard Bunce’s home transformed into a North Pole.



Thanks to thoughtful planning, a generous bequest to ABHMS from Wanda’s and Richard’s estate ensures their

caring will keep on helping others through grants to retired American Baptist ministers and those in need.

Wanda’s father, the Rev. Richard Mikolon, an American Baptist pastor, inspired the Bunce’s gift. Mikolon ministered to Polish immigrant groups in Buffalo, New York; Erie, Pennsylvania; and Plainfield, New Jersey. Wanda remembered lean times as a child, and she knew her parents’ financial insecurity extended into retirement.

Their legacy gift to ABHMS will continue Wanda and Richard’s spirit of generosity and the gift-giving tradition established during their lifetimes.

Pastor Joseph H. Ayala Latino/a Ministries Endowment: A Heart for Latino/a Ministry

Church of the New Covenant (CNC) in Phoenix was established as an American Baptist Church on September 18, 1983, under the direction of Pastor Ayala. A few members from a mainline Hispanic church were moved to action when a group of 12 men from El Salvador died from heat stroke while crossing the Arizona desert. They were the first wave of persons

fleeing their country’s violence and seeking asylum in the U.S. Pastor Ayala along with those few members joined with other small faith groups to offer assistance.

CNC never owned a building. When Pastor Ayala transitioned in year 2000, the home of succeeding pastor, Josefina E. Durán, became a house church. Over the past several years the membership at CNC declined and the remaining members made the painful decision to close the church and use its assets, \$100,000, to fund three areas critical to the church’s historical purpose and focus: immigration of Latinos, including undocumented persons; Latino/a education/scholarships; and Latinos/a with disabilities.
